The Scholarship applica on process is open to high school seniors and transfer students who have applied, been accepted, or deposited to an eligible on ground JWU undergraduate program before January 15, 2025. Eligible programs are: Applied Food Science, Baking & Pastry Arts (A.S. or B.S.), Culinary Arts (A.S. or B.S.), Culinary Nutri on, Culinary Science & Product Development, Diete cs and Applied Nutri on, Food & Beverage Industry Management and Food & Beverage Entrepreneurship.
